Below is a list of commonly asked or commonly submitted **ineligible** expenses under the [Transportation Fringe Benefit](#) (IRS Tax code 132f).

### Aviation Travel

**Car Sharing Subscriptions** – i.e., Enterprise CarShare, ZipCar
